

2023 FIRST QUARTER QUARTERLY LABOUR FORCE SURVEY REPORT

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1.0 Introduction

Quarterly Labour Force Survey (QLFS) is a national household based survey conducted in both rural and urban areas across all provinces in Zimbabwe.

2.0 Objectives of the Survey

The primary objectives of the Quarterly Labour Force Survey are to establish:

- a) Employment status of the labour force
- b) Employment in the informal sector
- c) Income levels
- d) Labour migration
- e) Labour underutilisation
- f) Unemployment level
- g) Youth not in employment, education or training

3.0 Survey Methodology

A two stage sample design was used. The first stage was selection of enumeration areas using probability proportional to size. The second stage entailed selection of households in the selected enumeration areas using systematic random sampling technique. A total of 12,500 households were selected from 500 enumeration areas. The response rate was 95.2 percent.

4.0 Definitions of Key Labour Market Indicators

- a. Working Age Population refers to persons age 15 years and above
- b. Labour Force = Employed Persons + Unemployed Persons
- c. Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR)

$$LFPR = \frac{Labour \ Force}{Working \ Age \ Population} \times 100$$

Where: Labour Force = Employed Persons + Unemployed Persons

c. Employment-to-Population Ratio (EPR)

$$EPR = \frac{Number of employed persons in working age population}{Working age population} \times 100$$

d. Employment by Industry

This indicator disaggregates employed persons into 21 sections of the International Standard Classification of all Economic activities (ISIC Revision 4) and expresses each sector as a percentage of total employment.

e. Employment by occupation

This indicator disaggregates employed persons into 10 major groups of the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO-08) and expresses each group as a percentage of total employment.

f. Employment in the informal economy

Employment in the informal economy covers two concepts; informal sector and informal employment. Employment in informal sector is determined by the characteristics of an enterprise in which a person is employed. An establishment is considered to be in the informal sector if it is not registered with the Registrar of Companies.

Informal employment is determined by the characteristics of the job a person holds. Informal employment includes the following jobs; own account workers and employers who work their own informal sector enterprises; unpaid contributing family workers irrespective of whether they work in formal or informal sector enterprises and paid employees not entitled to any of the following: contribution to pension fund by employer, paid annual leave, paid sick leave and written contract with employer.

g. Unemployment Rate

$$Unemployment Rate = \frac{Total number of unemployed persons}{Labour Force} \times 100$$

h. Youth Not in Employment, Education or Training

$$NEET = \frac{N_y - (N_{ye} + N_{yt})}{N_y} \times 100$$

Where: N_y is Total Number of youth

 N_{ye} is Number of youth in employment N_{yt} is Number of youth not in employment but in education or training)

Africa Union definition of youth: 15-34 years United Nations definition of youth: 15-24 years

i. Expanded unemployment rate

 $= \frac{(Total number of unemployed persons + PLF)}{(Labour Force + PLF)} \times 100$

Where *PLF* is Potential Labour Force




Figure 1: Labour Force Participation Rates by Province and Sex

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



Figure 3: Labour Force Participation Rates by Sex and Urban/Rural Areas

Figure 4: Labour Force Participation Rates by Age Group and Sex






Figure 5: Employment to Population Ratio by Province and Sex





Figure 7: Employment to Population Ratio by Age Group and Sex

Figure 8: Employment to Population Ratio by Sex and Urban/Rural Areas







Figure 9:Labour Force Participation Rates and Employment to Population Ratio Trends


Figure 10:Distribution of Employed Population, 15 Years and Above, by Sector of Employment and Sex

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
Figure 11:Percentage Change in Employed Population, 15 Years and Above, by Sector of Employment




Figure 14:Distribution of Employed Population, 15 Years and Above, by Industry




Figure 15:Distribution of Employed Population, 15 Years and Above, by Status in Employment


Figure 16:Distribution of Employed Population, 15 Years and Above, by Occupation and Sex





Figure 17:Distribution of Employed Population, 15 Years and above, in Informal Sector (Non-Agriculture) by Industry






Figure 21:Percentage Change in Unemployment Rates by Province


Figure 22: Unemployment Rates by Sex and Urban/Rural Areas










Figure 25:Unemployment Rate Trend






Figure 26:Expanded Unemployment Rates by Province and Sex




Figure 27:Distribution of Discouraged Job Seekers by Province and Sex

Discouraged job seekers: Male 432728 Female 417,181 Total 849,909




Figure 28:Proportion of Youth (15-24 Years) Not in Education, Employment or Training



Figure 29:Proportion of Youth (15-34 Years) Not in Education, Employment or Training by Province and Sex



Total Persons who lost jobs in the 3 months preceding survey: 100,944




Figure 32:Distribution of Labour Migrants by Country of Origin

Total labour migrants: 31,197




Figure 33:Distribution of Employed Persons with at Least One Form of Disability
