1. Introduction

This report presents road, air, rail and inland water transport statistics for 3rd quarter 2023. The statistics were compiled using administrative data obtained from the Zimbabwe Republic Police Statistics Department and relevant institutions under Ministry of Transport and Infrastructural Development.

2. Road Transport

2.1 Vehicles Registered for the first time

The number of vehicles registered for the first time decreased by 22.0%, from 23,849 in the second quarter of 2023 to 18,605 in the 3rd quarter of 2023. Light motor vehicle registrations decreased from 17,772 in the second quarter of 2023 to 14,045 in the 3rd quarter, reflecting a decrease of 21.0%. **(Table 2.2)**

2.2 Road traffic accidents

A total of 12,564 road traffic accidents were reported during 3rd quarter 2023, reflecting a 3.2 percent decrease from 12,981 reported in 2nd quarter 2023. (Figure 2.2). Of the 12,564 road traffic accidents that occurred in 3rd quarter 2023, 460 were fatal. (Figure 2.3).

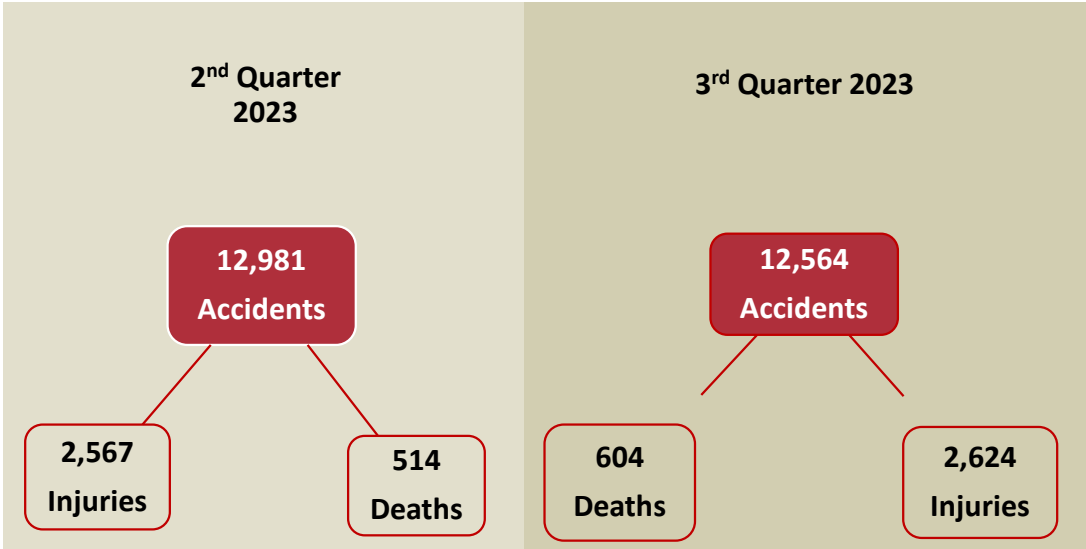


Figure 2.1: Reported road traffic accidents, 3rd Quarter 2023 and 2nd Quarter 2023.

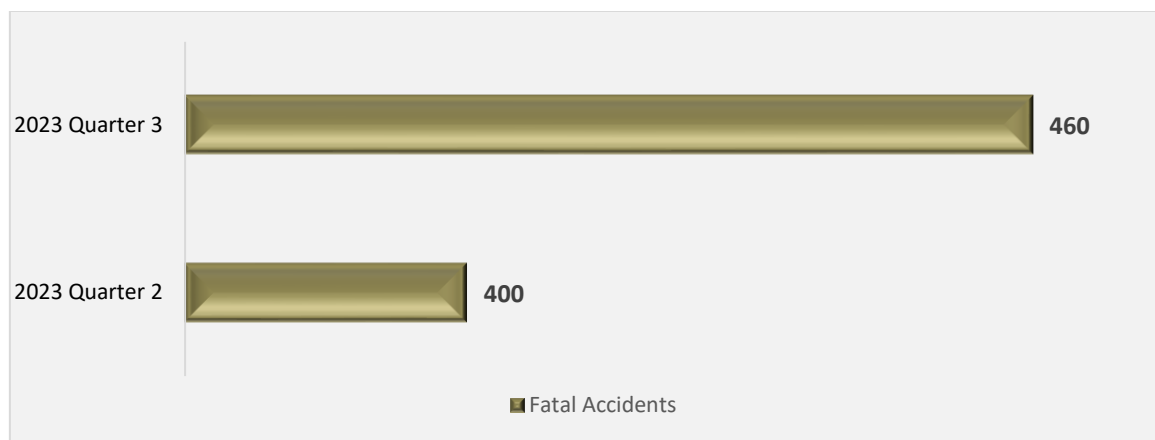


Figure 2.2: Reported road traffic fatal accidents, 3rd Quarter 2023 and 2nd Quarter 2023.

2.3 Driver’s Licences

At national level, **61,644** candidates undertook a certificate of competency test during 3rd quarter 2023, of which less than half (**43.2%**) succeeded. **(Table 2.4)**

In all provinces except Bulawayo, proportions of candidates who passed provisional driver’s licenses tests during 3rd quarter 2023, were above fifty percent, ranging from 59.9 percent in Midlands to 78.0 percent apiece in Mashonaland East and Mashonaland Central. About eighty percent of the individuals who were retested, succeeded. **(Table 2.5)**

3. Air Transport

3.1 Flights and air passenger movement

All airports reported more flights (military flights excluded) in the 3rd quarter than in second quarter 2023. Victoria Falls International Airport recorded 21.9 percent increase in flights from 3,815 in 2nd quarter to 4,652 in 3rd quarter 2023 (**Figure 3.1**).

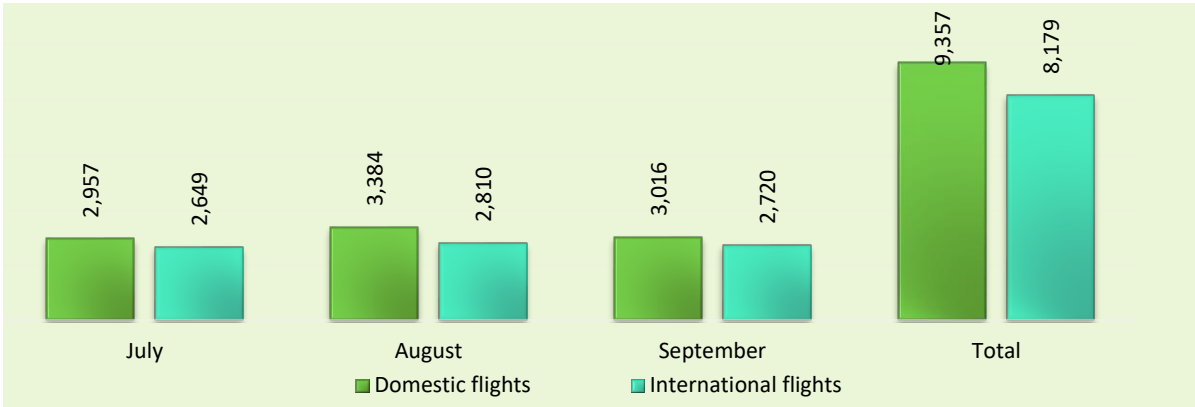


Figure 3.3: Domestic and International flights by months: 3rd Quarter 2023

During 3rd quarter 2023, highest number of flights for both domestic and international were recorded in August. **(Figure 3.3)**

4. Inland Water Transport

A total of 121 inland water vessels were registered for the first time during 3rd quarter 2023, depicting a 1.6 percent decrease from 123 recorded in 2nd quarter 2023. (Table 4.1).

5. Rail Transport

5.1 Railway Tonnage

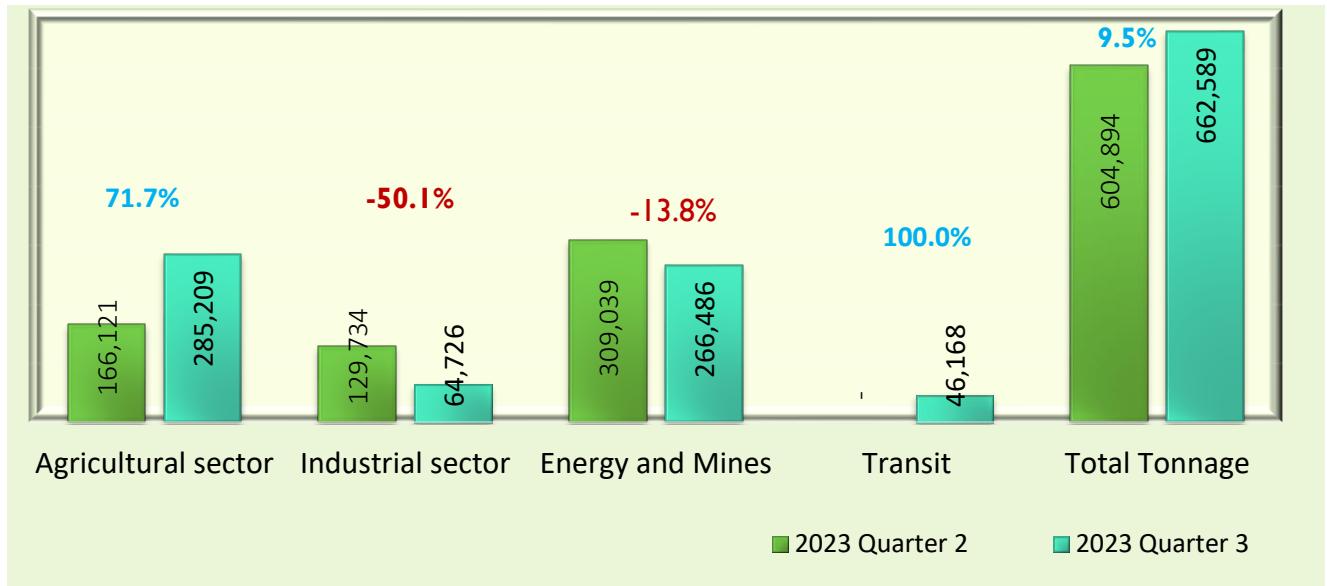
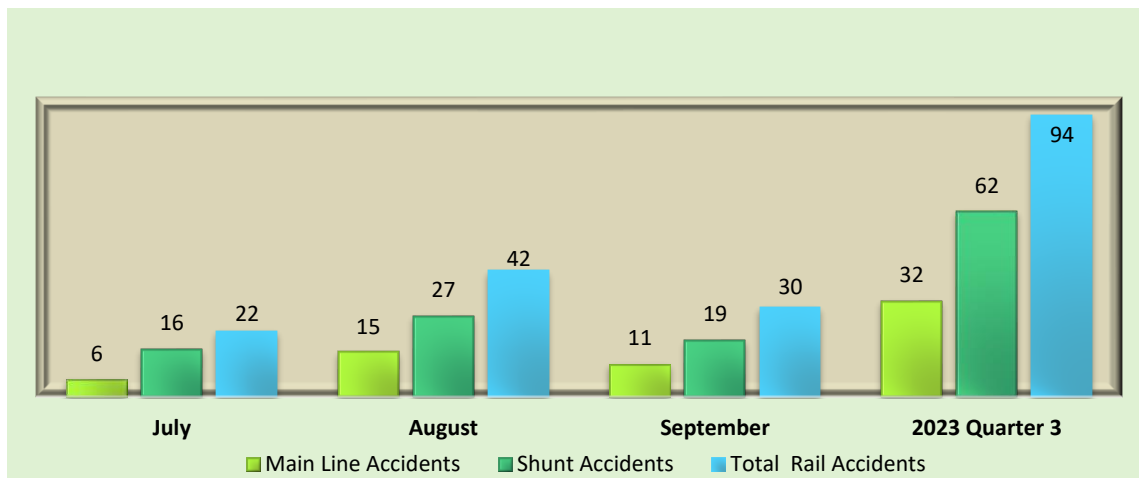


Figure 5.1: Railway tonnage in 3rd and 2nd quarter 2023 by type of service rendered

During 3rd quarter 2023, the volume of goods transported through rail was **662,589** net tonnes. A quarter-on-quarter comparison showed a **9.5** percent increase from **604,894** net tonnes recorded in 2nd quarter 2023. (Figure 5.1)

5.2 Railway Transport Accidents

A total of 94 rail accidents were reported in the 3rd quarter of 2023, from which, 62 were from shunt lines. (Figure 5.2)
