1. Introduction

This report presents road, air, rail and inland water transport statistics for 4th quarter 2023. The statistics were compiled using administrative data obtained from the Zimbabwe Republic Police Statistics Department and relevant institutions under Ministry of Transport and Infrastructural Development.

2. Road Transport

2.1 Vehicles Registered for the first time

During the 4th quarter 2023 first time registered vehicles were **27,441** reflecting a **32.2%** increase from 3rd quarter 2023. The number of light motor vehicles registered for the first time increased by **34.8%** from **14,405** during 3rd quarter 2023 to **21,550** in 4th quarter 2023. **(Table 2.1)**

2.2 Road traffic accidents

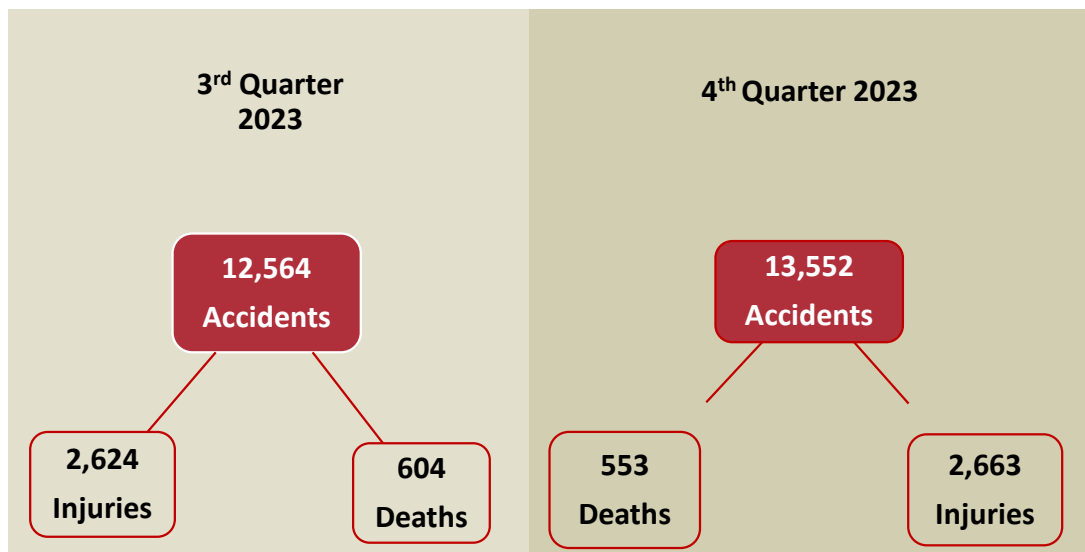


Figure 2.1: Reported road traffic accidents, 4th Quarter 2023 and 3rd Quarter 2023.

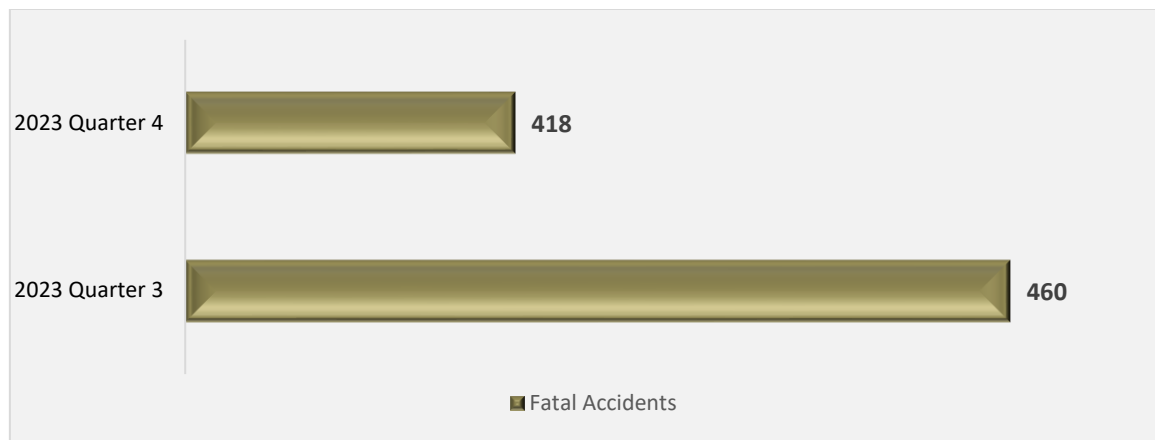


Figure 2.2: Reported road traffic fatal accidents, 4th Quarter 2023 and 3rd Quarter 2023.

A total of **13,552** road traffic accidents were reported during 4th quarter 2023, reflecting a 7.9 percent increase from **12,564** reported in 3rd quarter 2023. (Figure 2.1). Of the **13,552** road traffic accidents that occurred in 4th quarter 2023, 418 were fatal. (Figure 2.2).

2.3 Driver’s Licences

At national level, **70,461** candidates undertook a certificate of competency test during 4th quarter 2023, of which less than half (**39.4%**) succeeded. **(Table 2.3)**

In all provinces except Manicaland (**59.7%**) and Mashonaland East (**61.8%**), proportions of candidates who passed the certificate of competence tests during 4th quarter 2023, were less than **50 percent**, ranging from **30.3 percent** in Midlands to **42.6 percent** in Matabeleland South. **(Table 2.4)**

3. Air Transport

3.1 Flights and air passenger movement

All international airports reported a decrease in flights (military flights excluded) in 4th quarter compared to 3rd quarter 2023. During 4th quarter 2023, Victoria Falls International Airport recorded **3,476** flights, depicting a **25.3 percent** decrease from **4,652** in 3rd quarter 2023. Other airports recorded **66.9 percent** increase in flights from **3,931** in 3rd quarter to **6,562** in 4th quarter 2023 (**Figure 3.1**).

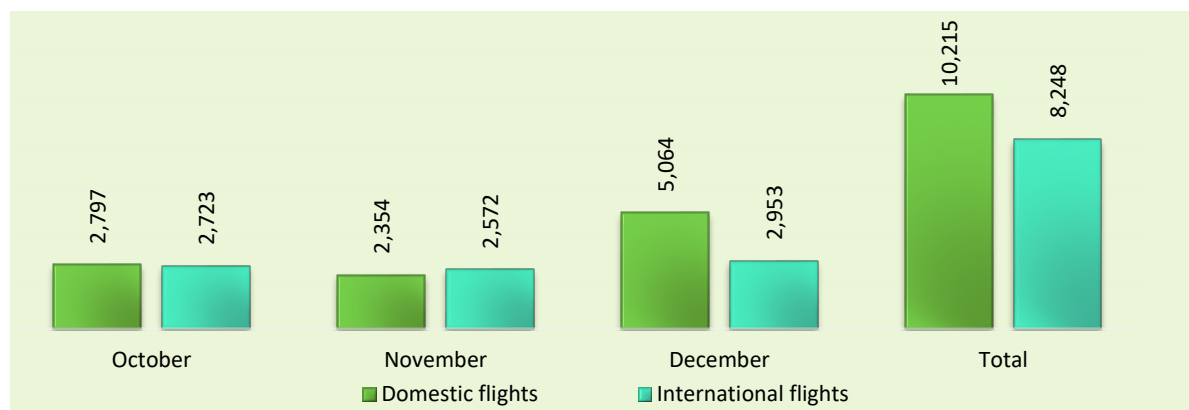


Figure 3.3: Domestic and International flights by months: 4th Quarter 2023

4. Inland Water Transport

5. Rail Transport

5.1 Railway Tonnage

In 4th quarter 2023, the volume of goods transported through rail excluding tonnage in transit was **433,031** net tonnes. A quarter-on-quarter comparison showed a **29.8 percent** decrease in 4th quarter 2023.

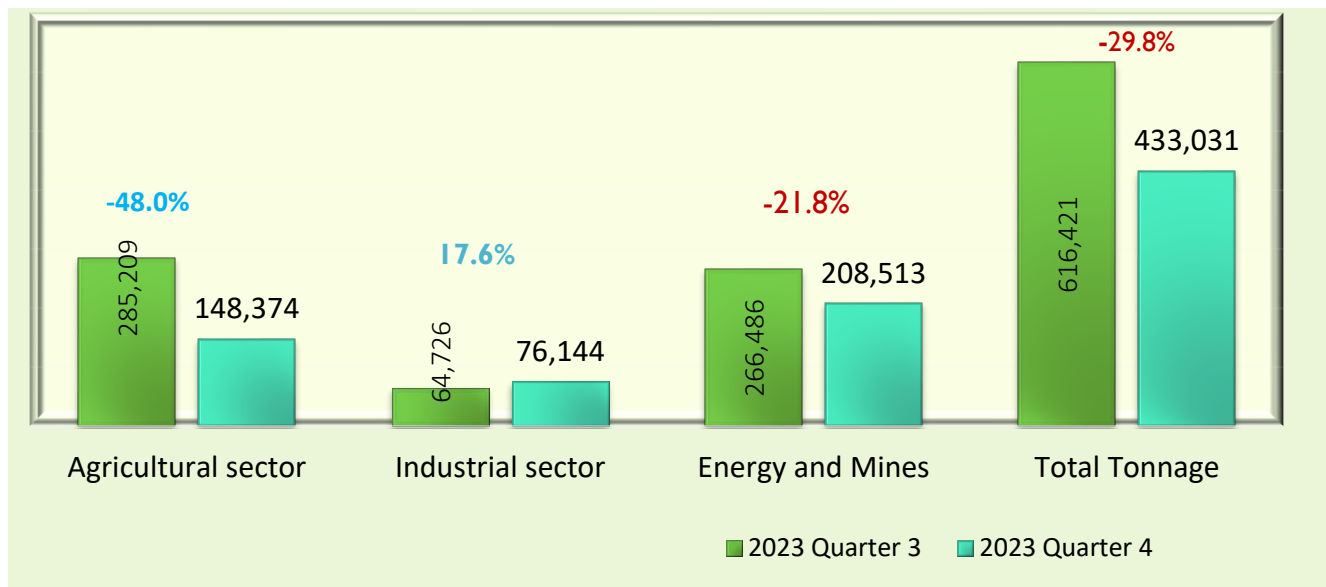


Figure 5.1: Railway tonnage in 4th and 3rd quarter 2023 by type of service rendered

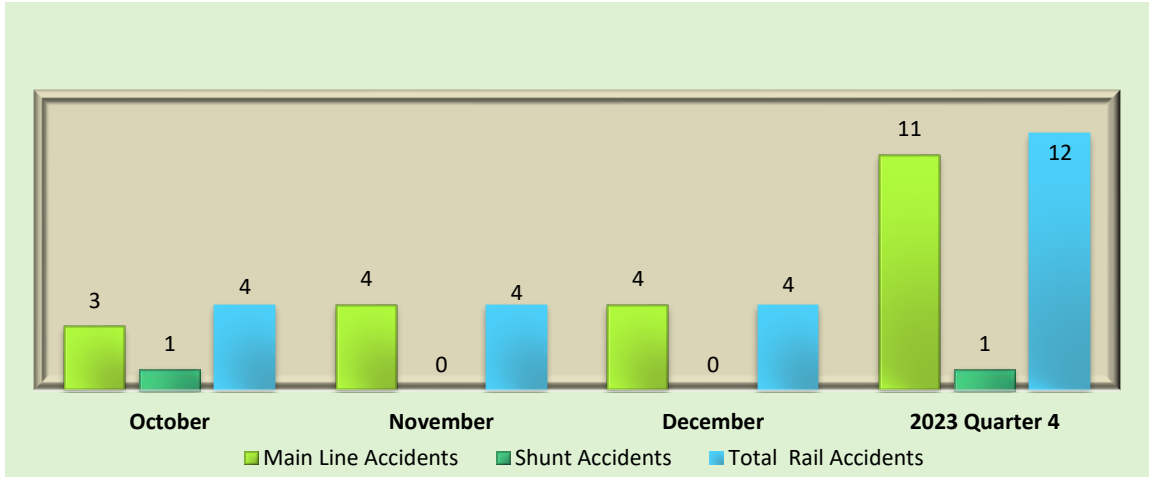


Figure 5.2: Railway accidents ,4th quarter 2023

A total of 12 rail accidents were reported in the fourth quarter of 2023, from which, 11 were from main lines. (Figure 5.2)
