Preface

The Zimbabwean community has of late experienced more incidences of crime that include theft, robbery, sexual offences, drug-related crimes and murder. Such vices leave society entangled with emotional, psychological and physical damage. In addition, acts of crime may result in tensions within families, financial losses, expenditures on private security measures, mental disorders and loss of life. At the Government level, resources spent on law enforcement and criminal justice come at the expense of social service delivery.

To this end, the production of crime statistics plays a vital role in shaping policies and planning within the criminal justice system. Crime statistics reveal trends in criminal activities, enabling policymakers, law enforcement agencies and other stakeholders to develop evidence-based strategic interventions to curb the rise in crime rates.

The information contained in this publication is based on data collected from the Zimbabwe Republic Police (ZRP) Crime Report and Disposal System. The crime statistics herein are aggregated based on the United Nations International Classification of Crime for Statistical Purposes (ICCS) adopted in 2016. The ICCS provides a framework for the systematic production and comparison of statistical data across different criminal justice institutions and jurisdictions.

We acknowledge that the information on crime presented in this publication is not exhaustive due to limitations on recorded data.

I want to take this opportunity to extend my appreciation to our technical partners, the ZRP for the provision of data and to the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) for their guidance in applying the ICCS framework.

1.0 Introduction

ZIMSTAT publishes statistics on levels and trends of crime in Zimbabwe based on police-recorded crime data, collected monthly. Recorded crime figures exclude crimes that have not been reported to the police or incidents that the police decide not to record as crimes.

Highlights of Reported Crimes




Figure 1: Highlights of Offences Committed in the First Quarter of 2025

Figure 1 shows highlights of offences reported during the first quarter of 2025. Theft and assaults are the most common offences recorded during the first quarter of 2025.

1.1 Trends in Police Recorded Crime

The police recorded 310,876 offences from January to March 2025, a 33.7 percent increase from 232,593 in the fourth quarter of 2024.




Figure 2.1: Crime Rates among the Different Types of Offences

The national crime rate was 2,048.1 crimes per 100,000 people, an uptick from 1,532.3 per 100,000 observed in the fourth quarter of 2024 (Table 1). This implies that for every 100,000 people, about 2,048 crimes were recorded. Further, Figure 2.1 depicts the crime rates per 100,000 population for the types of offences. The crime rate for offences committed against public order and state security was 1,172.1 per 100,000 population, an increase from 690 per 100,000 recorded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Vulnerability to crime varies by province as shown in *Table 2*. In Bulawayo, Harare and Masvingo Policing Provinces, vulnerability to crime was above the national average. The crime rate in Bulawayo Province more than doubled the national crime rate, at 4,941.3 per 100,000 people against the national average of 2,048.1.

Of the 310,876 cases recorded in the first quarter, 177,909 were crimes against public safety and state security. The second most common type of crime recorded was Acts against property only, with 51,599 cases. Acts leading to harm or intending to cause harm to the person were 39,696.

The total number of persons charged by the police for all offences was 252,357, of which 87 percent were male (*Table 3*). The rate for charged persons for all offences stood at 1,662.6 per 100,000 people, an increase from 1,138 in the fourth quarter of 2025. The rate for charged males for all offences was 3,026.6 persons per 100,000 males, while it was 402.3 for females, using the same weight.
