

## Introduction

- 1. ZIMSTAT publishes statistics on levels and trends of crime in Zimbabwe based on police-recorded crime data, collected on a monthly basis.
- 2. Recorded crime figures exclude crimes that have not been reported to the police
- 3. The information contained here is based on data collected from the Zimbabwe Republic Police (ZRP) Crime Report and Disposal System.
- 4. The crimes are classified according to the United Nations International Classification of Crime for Statistical Purposes (ICCS) adopted in 2016.


#### **National Crime Rate**




The police recorded 321,640 offences from April to June 2025, a 3.5 percent increase from 310,876 in the first quarter of 2025.

The national crime rate was 2,119.0 crimes per 100,000 people, an uptick from 2,048.1 per 100,000 observed in the first quarter of 2025.

# Crime Rate by Province – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2025 & 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2025 per 100,000 Population




Crime rates rose in most provinces in Q2 2025 compared to Q1, with the largest increases in Matabeleland South (693), Bulawayo (523.2), and Manicaland (379.5) per 100,000 population.



There were 177,909 offences committed in the 'Public safety and state security' category, constituting a crime rate of 1,172.1 per 100,000 population.

#### Acts leading to death or intending to cause death



There were 271 cases of intentional homicide recorded in the second quarter of 2025, reflecting a rate of 1.8 offences per 100,000 population.

#### Acts causing harm or intending to cause harm to the person



Assaults and threats category was the most frequent 'Act causing harm or intending to cause harm to the person'. The rate for assaults and threats stood at 173.7 per 100,000 population.

#### **Acts against property**



There were 35,911 cases of theft indicating a rate of 236.6 per 100,000 population .

#### Acts involving controlled drugs or other psychoactive substances




There were 2,533 cases of unlawful acts involving controlled drugs or precursors indicating a rate 16.7 per 100,000 population.

#### Acts involving fraud, deception or corruption

There were 2,684 cases of fraud and 55 cases of forgery/counterfeiting recorded indicating crime rates of 17.7 and 0.4 per 100,000 population, respectively.

#### Acts against public order, authority and provisions of the State



The number of offences recorded under 'Acts against public order behavioural standards' was 5,102, translating to a crime rate of 33.6 per 100,000 population.

During the 2025 second quarter, 191,997 cases of non-injurious traffic violations were recorded resulting in a crime rate of 1,264.9 per 100,000 population.

#### **Other Criminal Acts**



There were 3,248 cases of sexual violence recorded, representing a crime rate of 21.4 per 100,000 population.
