## **Explanatory Notes**

The report consists of a summary table and four sections dealing with:

- a) Immigrants
- b) Emigrants
- c) Visitors
- d) Residents

### **Immigrants include:**

- (i) Former residents of other countries intending to remain in Zimbabwe for at least twelve months.
- (ii) Temporary residents taking up employment for a limited period.
- (iii) Returning former residents who had declared themselves as emigrants when leaving the country but, nevertheless, remained away for more than one year.

### **Emigrants include:**

- (i) Residents, who on departure, declare they are leaving for more than twelve months
- (ii) Persons who recorded themselves as visitors on arrival but stayed more than twelve months

### **Visitors from abroad include:**

- (i) Residents of other countries who visit this country for periods not exceeding twelve months for any reason other than taking up employment.
- (ii) In transit visitors who enter the country en route to other destinations and who spend less than two nights in passing through the country.

### **Residents**

These are residents of Zimbabwe who go on visits abroad for periods not exceeding twelve months at any time who do not depart as emigrants.

The statistics contained in this report are mainly compiled from:

- (a) documents completed at the official ports by persons passing through or details derived from these documents and
- (b) other records kept at these ports

## **Chapter 1: Introduction**

### **1.1 Introduction**

The Zimbabwe National Statistical Agency through the Department of Immigration collects information on people who arrive in and those who depart from Zimbabwe through the official ports of entry and exit. Data are collected using Port Returns for visitors from abroad, returning residents and exitors. Collection of data on immigrants is done using the immigration statistical card.

### **1.2 Distribution of Official Ports of Entry and Exits.**

The list of all official ports of entry and exit is shown in Appendix 1. Matabeleland South has the highest number of ports of entry and exit (6), followed by Matabeleland North with four, while Mashonaland East, Midlands and Bulawayo have the lowest number, with one each.

## Chapter 2. Summary of Findings

### 2.1 Introduction

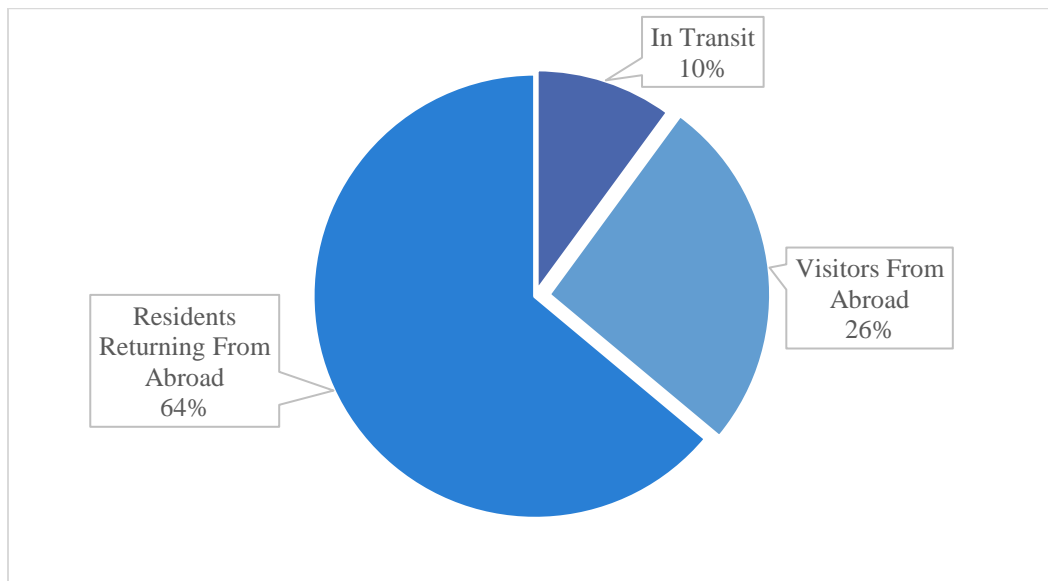


Figure 2.1: Distribution of the 2025 Fourth Quarter Arrivals by Category

The country received a total of 1,343,024 arrivals during the fourth quarter of 2025. The distribution of arrivals by category of visit is shown in Figure 2.1. Returning residents from abroad (64%) constituted the highest proportion of arrivals during the fourth quarter of 2025.

### 2.2 Immigrants

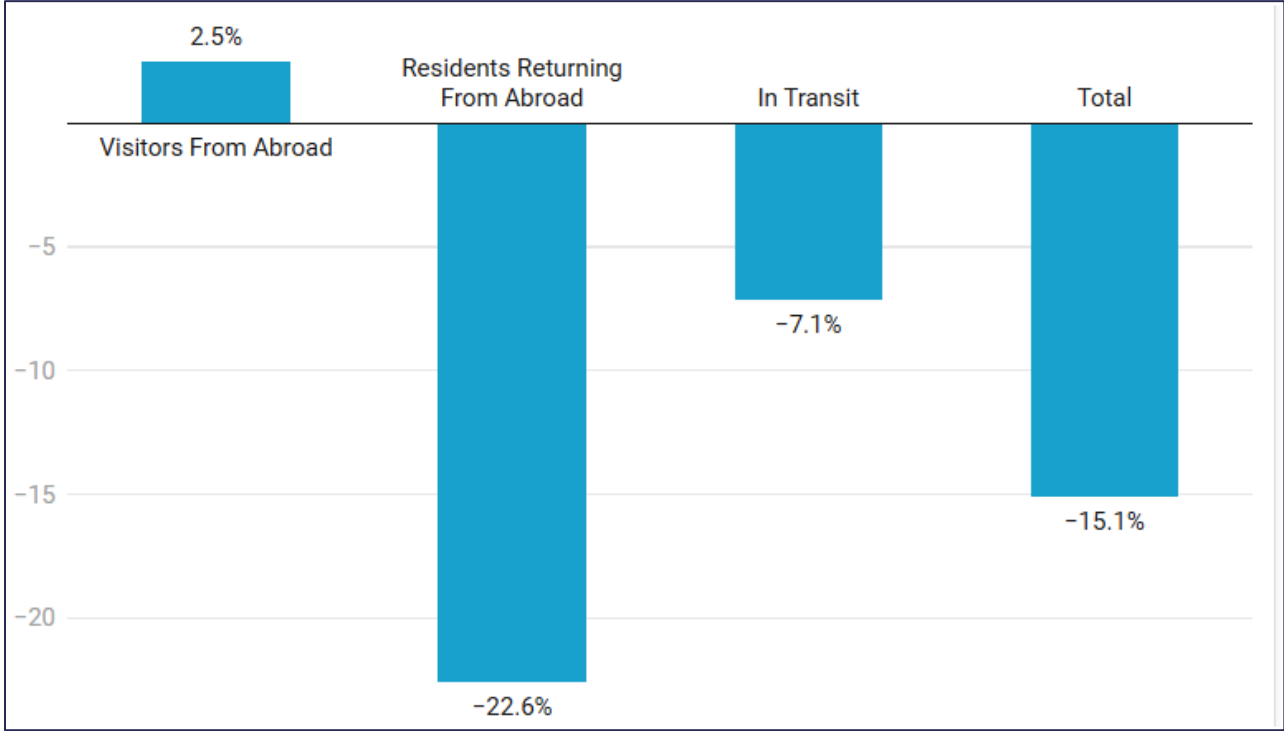
The Department of Immigration migrated from manual data processing to electronic data processing and data for immigrants could not be availed in time for the production of this report from the new system.

### 2.3 Visitors from Abroad

There were 484,413 visitors from abroad who came to Zimbabwe during the fourth quarter of 2025 compared to 472,745 in the same quarter for 2024 representing an increase of about 3 percent.

**2.4 Residents Returning from Abroad**

There were 858,611 residents returning from abroad during the fourth quarter of 2025 compared to 1,109,320 in the fourth quarter of 2024. This indicates a decrease of about 23 percent (Figure 2.2).

### Chapter 3: Arriving Visitors by Mode of Travel and Port of Entry

The number of visitors by their mode of travel and port of entry is shown in Figure 3.1. The modes of travel commonly used by visitors to Zimbabwe were air and road. The majority (74 %) of visitors used road transport when entering Zimbabwe.

#### 3.1 Air

The number of visitors coming to Zimbabwe who used air for their travel during the fourth quarter of 2025 was 126,789 representing 26 percent of all arriving visitors. The volume of visitors who arrived by air increased by about 42 percent from 104,267 in the fourth quarter of 2024. The majority (58%) of visitors who used air came through Robert Gabriel Mugabe International Airport followed by Victoria Falls Airport (34%) and Joshua Mqabuko Nkomo International Airport (6%).

### **3.2 Road**

A total of 357,624 arrivals constituting about 74 percent of total arrivals used road as their mode of travel to get into Zimbabwe in the fourth quarter of 2025. In comparison, 368,478 arrivals were recorded at road ports of entry in the fourth quarter of 2024 indicating a decrease of about three percent. Most of the arriving visitors by road came through Forbes (85,816) followed by Beitbridge (80,231) and Victoria Falls Road (48,373).

### **3.3 Rail**

No visitors were recorded through rail ports of entry for the fourth quarter of 2025.

## Chapter 4: Arriving Visitors by Purpose of Visit

### 4.1 Introduction

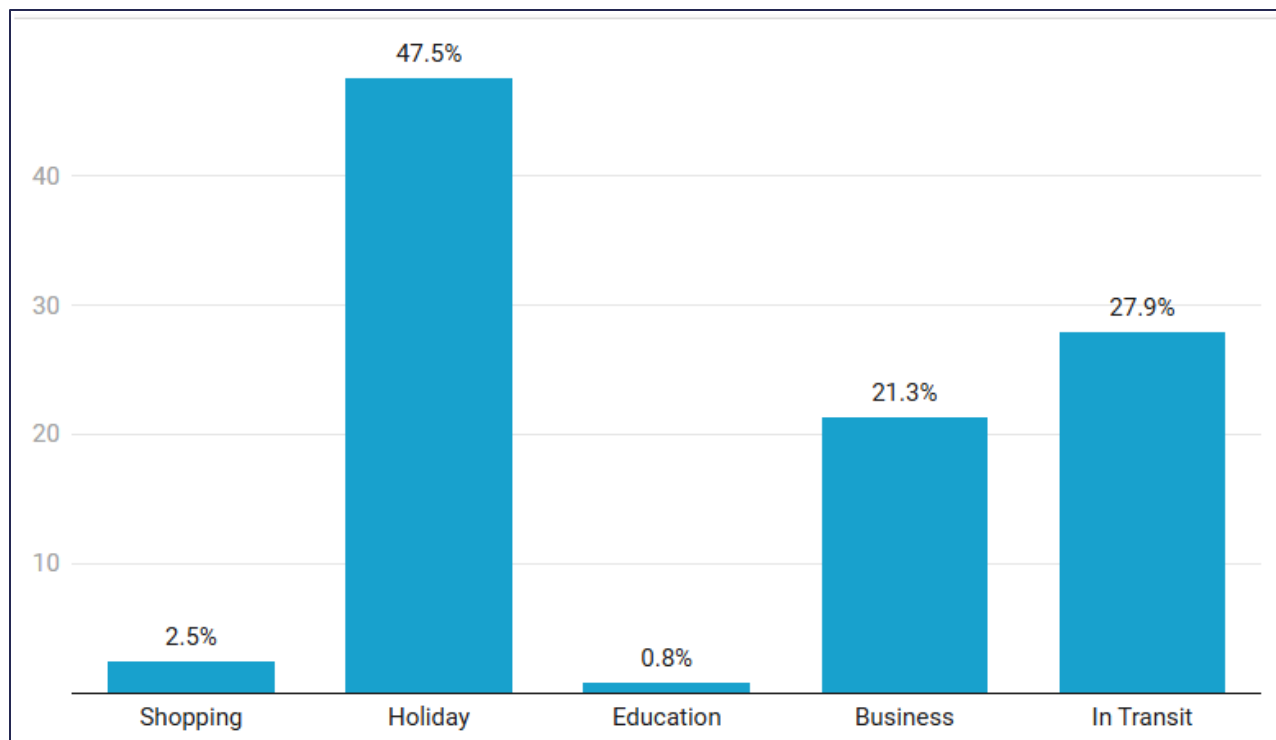


Figure 4.1: Distribution of 2025 Fourth Quarter Visitors from Abroad by Purpose of Visit

A total of 484,413 visitors from abroad entered the country during the fourth quarter of 2025 for various purposes which were categorised into in-transit, business, educational, holiday and shopping. The proportion of visitors who came for holiday was just over 47 percent (Figure 4.1).

### 4.2 In Transit

During the fourth quarter of 2025, there were 135,134 in-transit visitors compared to 145,483 during the same quarter in 2024 representing a decrease of about 7 percent.

### 4.3 Business

The number of arriving visitors who came for business purposes increased by close to 18 percent from quarter ending December 2024 compared to the same quarter in 2025. The number increased from 87,536 to 103,083.

### 4.4 Education

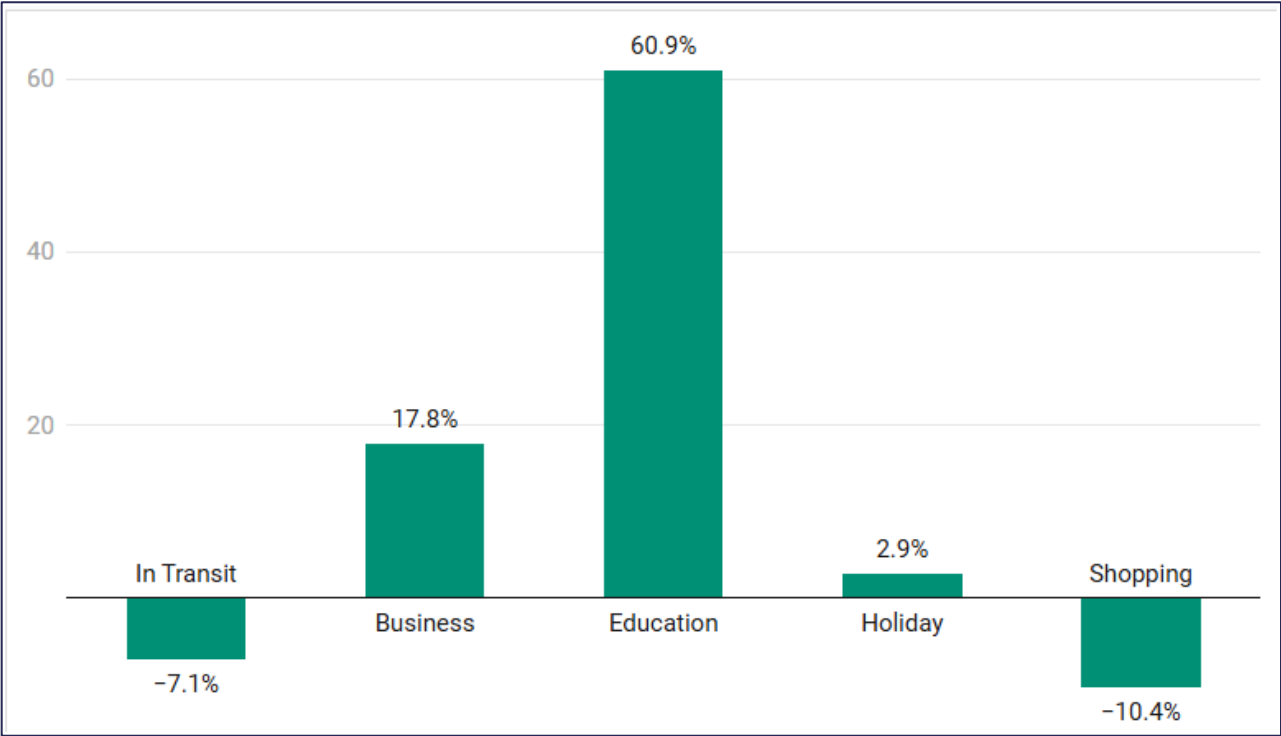
Visitors who came to Zimbabwe for educational purposes in the fourth quarter of 2025 increased by 61 percent from the same quarter in 2024. There were 3,827 education visitors in the quarter ending December 2025 compared to 2,378 for the fourth quarter of 2024.

**4.5 Holiday**

The number of holiday visitors increased from a figure of 223,852 in the fourth quarter of 2024 to 230,271 for the same quarter in 2025; an increase of about three percent.

**4.6 Shopping**

There were 12,830 visitors in the quarter ending December 2025 who came for shopping down from a figure of 13,496 visitors recorded for the same quarter in 2024. This represents a decrease of around 10 percent (Figure 4.2).

## Chapter 5: Arriving Visitors by Country of Last Permanent Residence

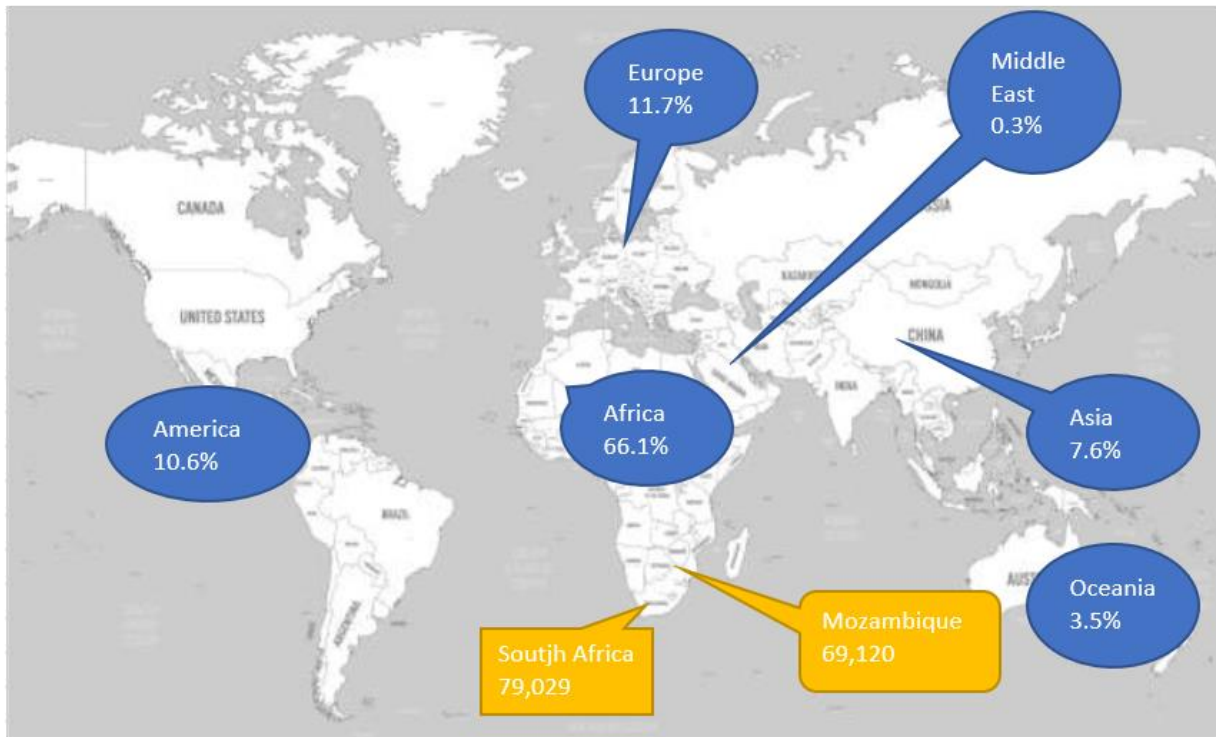


Figure 5.1: Distribution of 2025 Fourth Quarter Visitors by Country of Permanent Residence

During fourth quarter of 2025, there were 231,007 arriving visitors (excluding those in-transit) whose country of last permanent residence was in Africa compared to 225,144 who arrived in the same quarter in 2024. This represents an increase of about three percent. The majority of these visitors came from South Africa (79,029) followed by Mozambique (69,120) and Zambia (28,610) (Figure 5.1).
