## ZIG CONSUMER PRICE INDEX MARCH 2024 (APRIL 2024 = 100)

### Consumer Price Index

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) was **100** in April 2024.

### Period of Data Collection

Data on prices were collected during the period 11<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> April 2024. Hence, the changes in prices in this report refer to that period of data collection.

### Methodology

In April 2024, Zimbabwe introduced the Zimbabwe Gold (ZiG) currency. Therefore, the index reference for the Consumer Price Index for the ZiG currency is April 2024. This means during the month of April 2024, there is no month-on-month and year-on-year inflation rates. The month-on-month inflation rate for the ZiG currency will be computed starting in May 2024 and going forward and year-on-year inflation rate will be computed in April 2025 and going forward according to the international recommended methods.

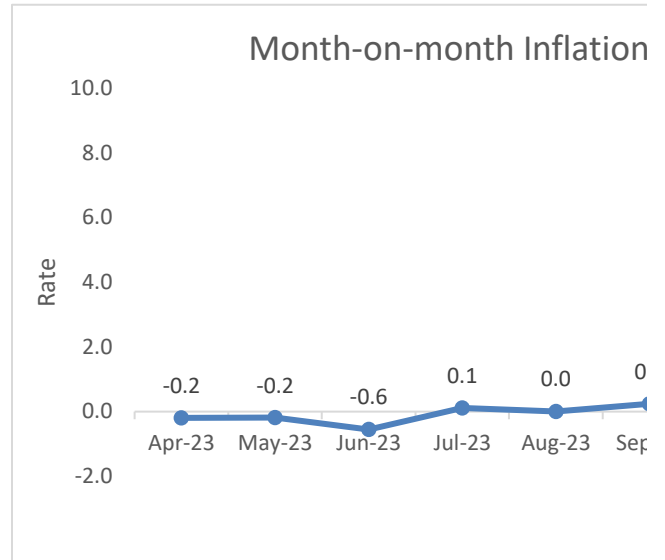
