Introduction

This report presents road, air, rail and inland water transport statistics for 1st quarter 2025. The statistics were compiled using administrative data obtained from the Zimbabwe Republic Police Statistics Department and relevant institutions under the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructural Development.

Road Transport

1.1 Vehicles Registered for the First Time

The number of vehicles registered for the first time during 1st quarter 2025 was **18,214**, reflecting a **9.0** percent decrease from **20,019** registered in 4th quarter 2024. (Table 2.1)

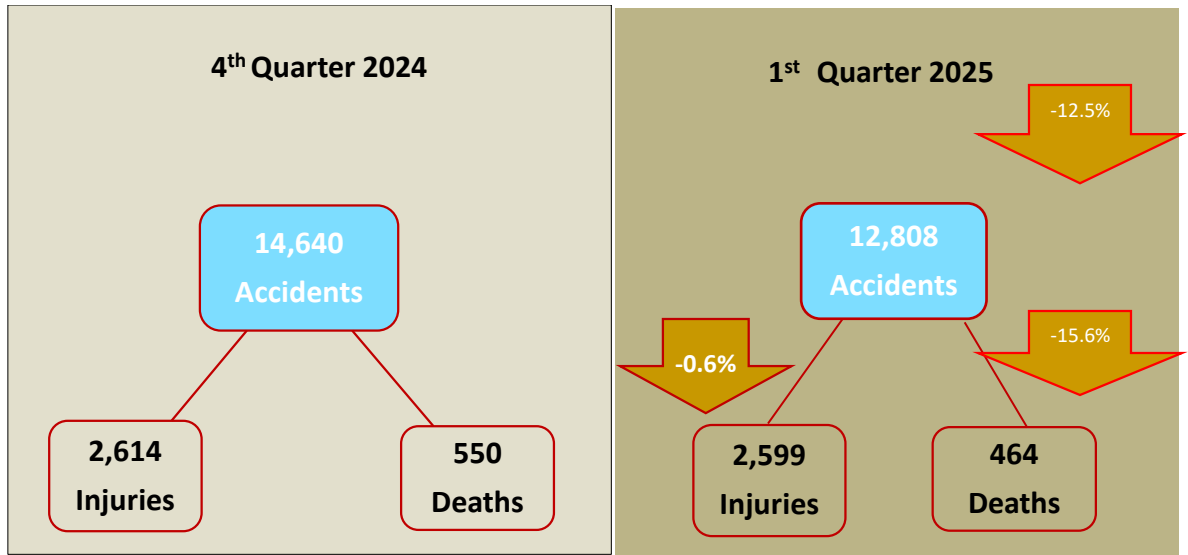

1.2 Road Traffic Accidents

A total of **12,808** road traffic accidents were reported in 1st quarter 2025, representing a **12.5** percent decrease from **14,640** accidents reported during the 4th quarter of 2024. Consequently, the number of deaths resulting from the reported road traffic accidents fell by **15.6** percent, from **550** to **464**. The number of fatal accidents also decreased by **15.5** percent from **449** in 4th quarter 2024 to **378** during the quarter under review (Figures 2.1 and 2.2).

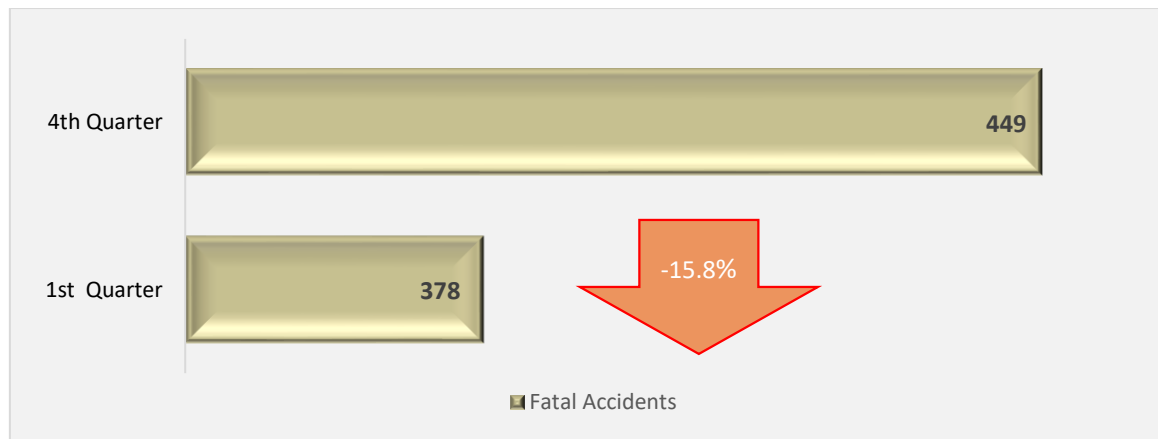


Figure 0.2: Fatal Road Traffic Accidents Reported: 1st Quarter 2025 and 4th Quarter 2024.

1.3 Driver's Licence

Compared to the preceding quarter, the proportion of successful candidates for the Certificate of Competency test, rose from **52.9** percent to **53.1** percent in 1st quarter 2025, while that for retests increased from **86.3** percent to **87.7** percent. (Table 2.2)

Air Transport

1.4 Flights and Air Passenger Movement (excluding military flights)

A total of **11,376** flights were recorded in 1st quarter 2025, marking a decrease of **41.9** percent when compared to **19,588** recorded in the preceding quarter. Consequently, the total number of air passengers decreased by **19.5** percent, from **622,727** to **501,275**. All Airports recorded reductions in flights in first quarter 2025. (Tables 3.1 and 3.2).

Both domestic and international flights recorded month-on-month decreases in February and month-on-month increases in March 2025. International flights increased from the February depression of **2,200** to **2,522** in March, as domestic flights rose from **1,221** to **1,762** between the two months. (Figure 3.1)

1.5 Air freight

There was a **38.8** percent decline in air freight transported, from **4,851** tons recorded in 4th quarter 2024 to **2,968** tons during 1st quarter 2025. As inbound freight decreased by **58.1** percent, outbound freight decreased by **17.3** percent during the quarter under review. (Figure 3.4)

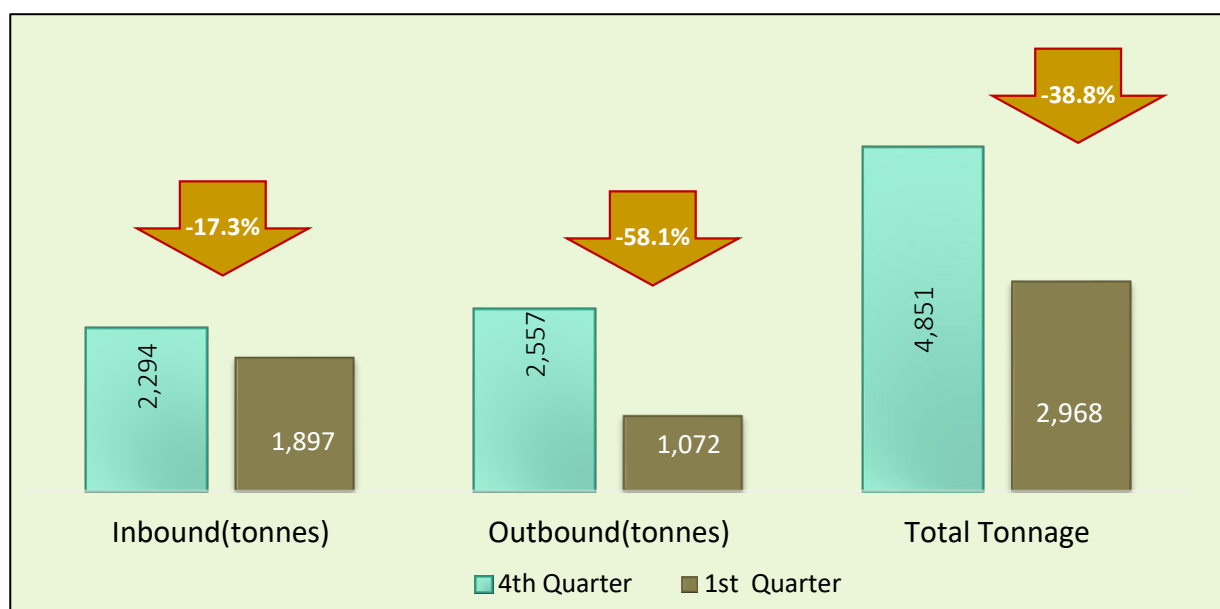


Figure 0.2: Air Freight (Inbound and Outbound) Transported in 1st 2025 and 4th Quarter 2024

Inland Water Transport

In comparison with the preceding quarter, Certificates of survey increased by **45.9** percent in 1st quarter 2025, while the number of newly registered vessels and licenses issued, decreased by **49.4**

percent, **21.7** percent, respectively. A decline of **13.5** percent was recorded in permits issued, from **37** to **32**. (Table 4.1)

Rail Transport

1.6 Rail Transport Tonnage

Compared to the preceding quarter, the volume of goods transported by rail during 1st quarter 2025 decreased by **35.9** percent. Tonnage transported for the Agricultural and Industrial Sectors decreased by **86.7** percent and **1.7** percent respectively, while that for Energy and Mines Sector decreased by **5.8** percent. (Figure 5.1)

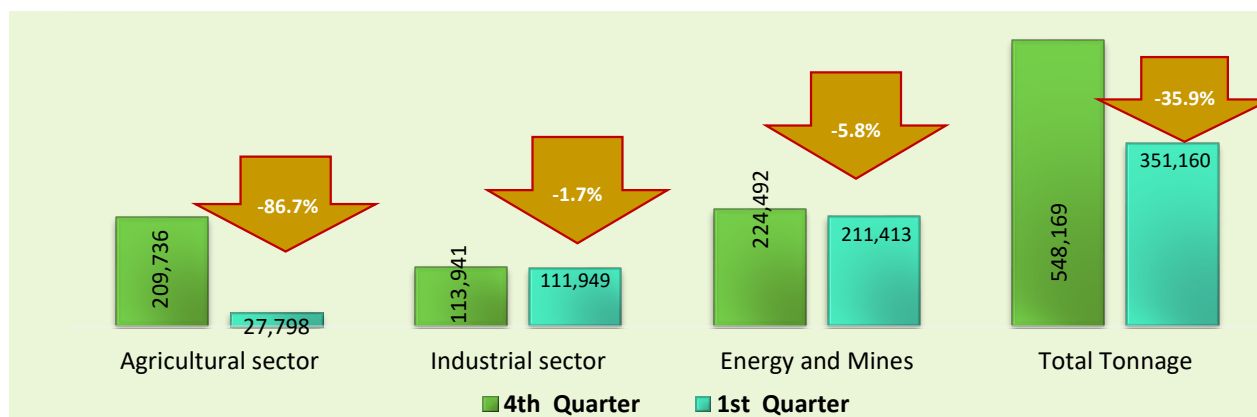


Figure 0.1: Railway Tonnage by Sector where Service was Rendered, 4th Quarter 2024 and 1st Quarter 2025

1.7 Rail Traffic Accidents¹

A total of **58** rail traffic accidents were reported in 1st quarter 2025, representing a **51.7** percent decrease when compared to **120** accidents recorded in the preceding quarter. Main line accidents increased by **66.7** percent from **21** in the preceding quarter to **35** during the quarter under review. (Figure 5.2)

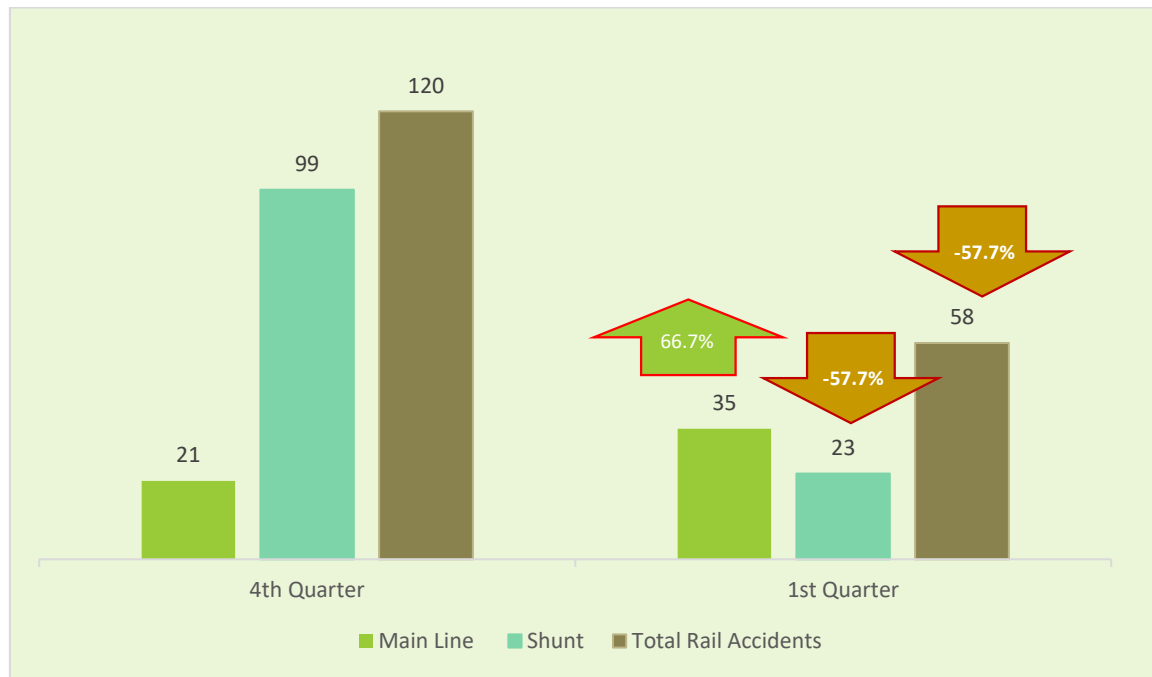


Figure 0.2: Rail traffic accidents, 1st Quarter 2025
